

### Storm Summary 1/5/2017 (Preliminary)

The latest rainfall event has moved east of Los Angeles County. Forecasts call for light rain to occur through this morning and early afternoon. Accumulations generally were between 0.20 and 0.50 inches in the valleys and 0.24 to 1.02 inches in the mountains. Storm water capture facilities were activated in the South Area. Approximately 100 acre-feet (33 million gallons) of storm water was captured at the spreading grounds. That's enough water for 800 people for one year. The attached map shows the rainfall totals from this weather system as of Thursday, January 5, 2017 at 8:00 a.m.
