

Storm Summary 12-19-16 (Preliminary)

This last storm brought rain to Los Angeles County over the weekend (12/15/16 to 12/17/16). Rainfall totals were generally between 1.00 and 2.50 inches in the valleys with a high of 4.29 inches measured in the mountains. Storm water capture facilities were activated in the East, West and South Areas. Approximately 6,000 acre-feet (2 billion gallons) of storm water was captured at the spreading grounds. That's enough water for 48,000 people for one year. The attached map shows the rainfall totals from this weather system as of Saturday, December 17, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.
