# OVERVIEW

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- The Waste Board approved the City of Pomona's NDFE in 1996.
- The Task Force approved amendment No. 1 in June 2004.
- The City is proposing to amend its NDFE to replace the existing Pomona Municipal Direct Transfer Facility with a a large-volume transfer facility at the same location.

# OVERVIEW

- Pomona Municipal Direct Transfer Facility is currently permitted to receive up to 150 tpd
- The new facility would:
  - be named the First Street Transfer Station.
  - be permitted to receive up to 1,500 tpd.
  - would recover less than 5%.
- The facility operator, Universal Waste, Inc, will remain the same.


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
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- The City of Pomona and surrounding jurisdictions would utilize First Street Transfer Station.



# FIRST STREET TRANSFER STATION PROPOSAL

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- Construct a 23,000 sq. ft. transfer building with below grade (-6 feet) loadout bay and 18,600 sq. ft tipping floor within 4.5 acres.
- Construct an office/employee break room as part of the transfer building.
- Construct one 70-foot-above-ground truck scale and scale house.
- Provide 15 parking spaces.

# FIRST STREET TRANSFER STATION PROPOSAL

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- First Street Transfer Station will provide the following services to the City of Pomona and surrounding communities:
  - Accept municipal solid waste for transfer to a permitted landfill.
  - Accept green waste for transfer to a permitted greenwaste recycling facility or other user.
  - Floor sort a portion of the waste stream to recover recyclables.

# ESTIMATED QUANTITIES OF MATERIAL ENTERING THE PROPOSED FACILITY

- Municipal Solid Waste/C&D • 1,050 tpd
- Greenwaste • 440 tpd
- Recyclables (In MSW Loads) • 10 tpd
  
- Total • 1,500 tpd



# STAFF FINDINGS

The proposed NDFE Amendment No 2.:

1. Conforms with Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan
  - Incorporating First Street Transfer Station will not impair solid waste management activities in Los Angeles County

The proposed NDFE Amendment No 2.:

2. Complies with Environmental Regulations

- Amending the NDFE is not subject to environmental review. Thus, no environmental document was prepared.

# STAFF FINDINGS

The proposed NDFE Amendment No 2.:

3. Complies with State Law and Regulations
  - Amendment No. 2 complies with the facility description requirements in State regulations (Section 18752 et seq, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations)

# Staff Recommendations

- Concur with the subject amendment to the City of Pomona's NDFE
- Request the facility owner/operator to submit monthly reports on a quarterly basis to the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works.
